- TS&CC lies within the Toronto Harbour's jurisdiction – it is the responsibility of all members to obtain a Toronto Harbour License to operate their boat.
- Assignment of Winter Storage space does not constitute any agreement for a mooring. Moorings are assigned in accordance with the Waiting List. Temporary Moorings, if available pending permanent assignment, must be vacated on 48 hours notice if required.
- This application is for the above noted boat only, and any change in the use of the mooring assigned is subject to prior approval of the Board. The use of all TS&CC Moorings is subject to the By Laws of the Club. Upon assignment of either a Temporary or Permanent Mooring, I agree to abide by all the Rules and Regulations pertaining to the use of the moorings, and hereby authorize the Club to make any corrective repairs to my mooring tackle, as required, at my expense.
- If this application is accepted, I agree to abide by the Constitutions, By-laws and Rules and Regulations of the Club, and pay all Annual Dues and Fees for serviced rendered by the Club.

Waiver:
