Attention all CKO Members,

Premier Ford's recent announcement is great news for the Club and we now have procedures in place for CKO members to be able to access their boats when we reopen for stage 1. These procedures will go into effect immediately and will be updated as restrictions are modified in subsequent stages. Please note that access by car to the Club is currently not possible with both entrances blocked so please check for any updates as we are working with the City to see when these will be removed.

All members are required to read and strictly follow the Club's COVID Code of Conduct, but we do have additional measures that are specific to the CKO members to ensure that the Club can manage traffic flow on the premises. Boats should not be lent out to anyone (ex. Paddling Crew member) that is not an owner of the boat for stage 1. You are not there to hang out and congregate. As there will be other members on-site preparing for launch, please continue to be mindful of social distancing and Club COVID protocols.

We have designated 2 hour time slots between the hours of 7am – 7pm (last booking start time is 5pm) daily for CKO members to come down to the Club, whether it be to paddle, check on your boat and/or bringing your boat back to the club if it has been stored elsewhere for winter or remove it if you wish to take it off the premises for repairs or until the Club fully reopens. There will be a **MAXIMUM** of 6 people permitted per time slot. **All bookings must be done online – the link to this booking calendar with instructions will be sent directly to all CKO members in a separate email from the TSCC Paddling Director by Wed May 20.**

Please note the following important requirements for access to your boat and request a time slot:

- You must be a fully paid **CKO member** to book a time slot
- If a boat is **co-owned** by a person or spouse not on the annual invoice, proof must be sent to [tsc.paddling.officer@gmail.com](mailto:tsc.paddling.officer@gmail.com) with the name of the individual, the date their Paddling Crew fee was paid so it can be verified before any bookings will be approved
- There is no team or crew paddling allowed at this time, only individual C/K/O paddling is allowed with the exception if it's a 2-person boat co-owned with a paid member that is from the **same household**.
